

Cookie Policy

This cookie policy explains what cookies are, how we use them, the types of cookies we use (for example, the information we collect when using cookies and how that information is used), and how to manage your cookie settings.

Cookies are small text files used to store certain pieces of information. They are stored on your device when a website is loaded in your browser. These cookies help ensure that the website functions properly, enhance security, provide a better user experience, and analyze performance to identify what works well and what needs improvement.

How do we use cookies?

Like most online services, our website uses first-party and third-party cookies for various purposes. First-party cookies are basically necessary for the website to work properly; they don't collect any personally identifiable data.

The third-party cookies used on our website mainly help us understand how the site responds; they track how you interact with it; protect our services; provide relevant advertising; and improve your overall user experience, while also optimizing the speed of your future interactions on our website.

Types of cookies we use

Necessary

Necessary cookies are essential to enable the basic functions of this site, such as providing a secure login or adjusting your consent preferences. These cookies do not store personally identifiable information.

Cookie	Duración	Descripción
ASP.NET_SessionId	sesión	Issued by Microsoft's ASP.NET application, this cookie stores session data during a user's visit to the website.
CONSENT	2 years	YouTube sets this cookie through embedded YouTube videos and anonymously records statistical data.

Analytics

Analytical cookies are used to understand how visitors interact with the website. These cookies help provide information about metrics like the number of visitors, the bounce rate, the traffic source, and more.

Cookie	Duración	Descripción
__utma	2 years	This cookie is set by Google Analytics and is used to distinguish users and sessions. The cookie is created when the JavaScript library runs and there are no __utma cookies. The cookie is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.
__utmc	sesión	The cookie is set by Google Analytics and is deleted when the user closes the browser. It is used to allow interoperability with urchin.js, which is an older version of Google Analytics and is used together with the __utmb cookie to determine new sessions/visits.
__utmz	6 months	Google Analytics sets this cookie to store the traffic source or the campaign through which the visitor arrived at the site.
__utmt	10 minutes	Google Analytics sets this cookie to limit the request rate.
__utmb	30 minutes	Google Analytics sets this cookie to determine new sessions/visits. The __utmb cookie is created when the JavaScript library runs and there are no __utma cookies. It's updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.

Performance

Performance cookies are used to understand and analyze the website's key performance indicators, which helps provide a better user experience for visitors.

Advertisement

Advertising cookies are used to provide visitors with personalized ads based on the pages they visited before and to analyze the effectiveness of advertising campaigns.

Cookie	Duración	Descripción
YSC	sesión	The YSC cookie is set by YouTube and is used to track views of videos embedded on YouTube pages.
VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE	5 months and 27 days	A cookie set by YouTube to measure bandwidth that determines whether the user gets the new or old player interface.
yt-remote-device-id	Never	YouTube sets this cookie to save the video preferences of users who watch an embedded YouTube video.
yt-remote-connected-devices	Never	YouTube sets this cookie to save the video preferences of users who watch an embedded YouTube video.

Uncategorized

Other uncategorized cookies are those that are being analyzed and have not yet been classified into a category.
